

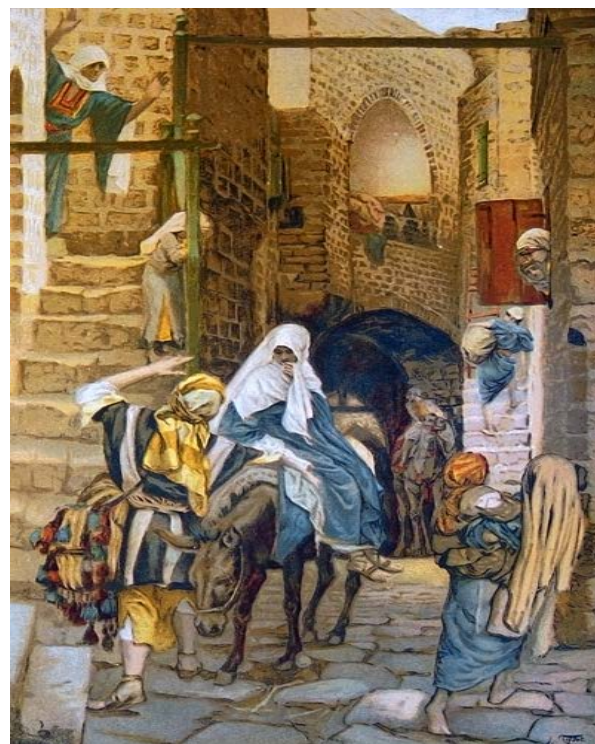
WE WHO FIRST HOPED IN CHRIST
